With great love and sadness, we announce the loss of Charlotte (Chalky) Ann Vuichard who passed peacefully in her sleep on April 24th, 2025, at the age of 86. Charlotte was born on September 24th, 1939, to Charles Vuichard and Angela (Bryant) Vuichard in St. Louis, MO. She had one half-brother Robert Groll and a former husband Richard Drexler who both preceded her in death. Charlotte was loved by family and friends and leaves behind a devoted family, her daughter Debra Drexler, and grandson Leland Drexler-Russell. Chalky particularly loved the architectural and natural beauty of Greece; and fashion, culture and cuisine of France. She was an adventurous traveler from

climbing up the bell towers of European churches to riding camels across the desert of Egypt. Her friendly nature allowed her to move easily through diverse countries and cultures.
