After the Navy, Guy graduated in 1958 from Washington University with a bachelor's degree in business and was hired by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company where his career spanned 33 years in various increasingly important roles leading up to Senior Vice President, Human Resources, Southwestern Bell Corporation. He retired in 1992 at the age of 60. During his career, he was a member of several business organizations and boards including SBC Technology Resources, Inc., AAIM Management Association, The Conference Board - Advisory Council on Human Resource Management, and the Employee Benefit Research Institute in Washington, D.C. where he made recommendations to the U.S. Congress. Additionally, he was active in his Church serving as an Elder and President of the Congregation. After retiring, he served as Chairman of the Board of Managers - Worker Benefit Plans, Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod. As a member of Forest Hills Country Club, Guy was an avid golfer playing many famous courses and golf events with Delores. He was gifted in woodworking, enjoyed traveling, skiing and spending time with his family.
