



## Helen D. Hume

July 16, 1933 - June 24, 2022

Helen D. Hume, 88, died June 24, 2022. Both an artist and art educator, she taught in the United States, Europe, and South America, notably at Parkway West Senior High School in the 1970s to 1990s. As a painter, printmaker, and photographer, she was in one-person shows and numerous juried exhibitions. She was also author of 11 books on art education and history. She received many awards and honors, including 2001 Missouri Higher Art Educator of the Year, Pillar of Parkway, and Manchester Citizen of the Year.

Helen is survived by daughter Susan Hume (John Baker); son David Hume (Carla Hume); seven grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; sister LuWayne Younghans; and many nieces, nephews, and close friends. She was preceded in death by her husband of 64 years, John C. "Jack" Hume, Jr., and daughter Connie.

Helen was born and raised in Kansas City, KS. She studied painting at Het Vrij Atelier in Antwerp, Belgium, and had undergraduate and graduate degrees from Webster University. Helen was an avid duplicate bridge player, golfer, and world traveler. She also volunteered for St. Louis Artists' Guild, St. Louis Symphony Volunteer Association, Manchester Arts, Bonhomme Church, and many other organizations.
