Rodney W. Flottmann, 61, of St. Louis, MO (formerly Champaign, IL) passed away at 8:30 AM on October 2, 2023, surrounded by family.

He was a loving husband to his wife, Cindy, and they shared 38 years of marriage together.

Born in Springfield, MO on February 20th, 1962, he was the son of William and Mildred Flottmann. He grew up in Arcola, Illinois where he and his sisters were subject to hard work on the farm, but plenty of barn shenanigans as well. After graduating from high school, he attended Southern Illinois University-Carbondale with a Marketing Degree, and later went on to earn his MBA from Sangamon State University (now University of Illinois-Springfield).
