Steven Joseph Robinette, age 61 of Creve Coeur, Missouri, Fortified with the Sacraments of Holy Mother Church, passed on Sunday, December 24, 2023 after an intense battle with metastatic pancreatic cancer. He was born on March 19, 1962 in St. Louis, Missouri, the youngest of three children of Chester “Chet” and Genevieve “Genny or Temi” (nee Pohlman) Robinette. He graduated from St. Louis University High School in 1980 and received his Bachelor’s degree from Central Missouri State, Warrensburg, Missouri in 1984. Flying was Steve’s true passion and he retired as a Captain after having worked for over thirty years for Trans World Express and then American Eagle/Envoy. In addition to flying, he had a deep love for the Black River and considered it to be his “happy place”. Also, after Steve’s dad died twelve years ago, he became the primary caregiver for his mother and provided very well for her. He was also very proud of his nieces and nephews and enjoyed spending time with them and their families.
