You could always find him on the course at least 3 times a week. His love of the game began with his father, who taught him how to play at the age of 12 and he continued playing until the incredible age of 90. Years ago, he got a hole in one on the same hole and course his father and uncle had aced before him. His passion of golf took him on many adventures around the country and the world. Some of Barry's highlights included attending the Masters, playing St. Andrews in Scotland, Kapalua in Hawaii, and Pebble Beach in California. His golf passion led to years of volunteering at many professional golf events. Barry was a lifelong member of Norwood Hills Country Club.

Twenty years ago, Barry and his wife Jan found a second home in St. Petersburg, Florida, where he loved playing golf in the warmer climate. In 2014, he joined Isla del Sol Country Club where he met many new people from all over the country who became his dear friends. At age 89 he and his teammate won the member-member golf tournament at Isla del Sol.
